### CLOSURE OF THE EXCHANGE FOR HARI RAYA AIDIL FITRI

Participants are hereby informed of the following:

#### 1. HARI RAYA AIDIL FITRI FALLS ON THURSDAY, 9 SEPTEMBER 2010

If Hari Raya Aidil Fitri falls on Thursday, 9 September 2010, Bursa Malaysia Group will be closed for business on Thursday, 9 September 2010 and Friday, 10 September 2010. Bursa Malaysia Group will resume business on Monday, 13 September 2010.

#### 2. HARI RAYA AIDIL FITRI FALLS ON FRIDAY, 10 SEPTEMBER 2010

If Hari Raya Aidil Fitri falls on Friday, 10 September 2010, the derivatives market operated by Bursa Malaysia Derivatives Berhad ("Bursa Derivatives") will be **closed for trading for the afternoon session of Thursday, 9 September 2010**.

The offices of Bursa Malaysia Group, however will still remain open in the afternoon on 9 September 2010.

Bursa Malaysia Group will be closed for business on Friday 10, September 2010 and will resume business on Monday, 13 September 2010.

Kindly take note of the following changes arising from the above closure of trading in the afternoon session on 9 September 2010.

#### 2.1 Trading Hours

The trading hours for the derivatives market will be modified as stated in the table below.

## 2.2 Reference to Business Day

Even though the trading hours have been shortened as mentioned under paragraph 2.1, all references to 'Business Day' in the Rules of Bursa Derivatives for the purpose of trading on 9 September 2010 will be treated as one (1) business day.

For example, under Rule 703.7(b)(ii), a good for day order remains valid 'only up to the end of the Business Day'. The end of 'Business Day' on 9 September 2010 is the end of the trading hours as stated in paragraph 2.1.

However, where references to 'Business Day' are in relation to non-trading related matters, 'Business Day' will be read as one (1) business day ending at the close of business of the Exchange on 9 September 2010.

For example, under Rule 301.8 the register of Participants is open for inspection by the public during any 'Business Day'. Business Day on 9 September 2010 is until the close of business on 9 September 2010.
